Rolling up his sleeves for a tussle this annual meeting season is Ian Greenwood, chairman of the Local Authority Pension Fund Forum. Acting for 46 local authority pension schemes with total assets of about £75bn, the LAPFF has pulled on the gloves against Terry Smith, calling on members to oppose the remuneration report at his Tullett Prebon. In March, it filed a shareholder resolution at Marks and Spencer calling for the appointment of an independent chairman by July next year. The Bradford city councillor and former trades union officer, who has been in the post since early 2008, is pushing for greater engagement with companies in which pension fund members invest - but has said he's "not looking to hit people over the head all the time".
