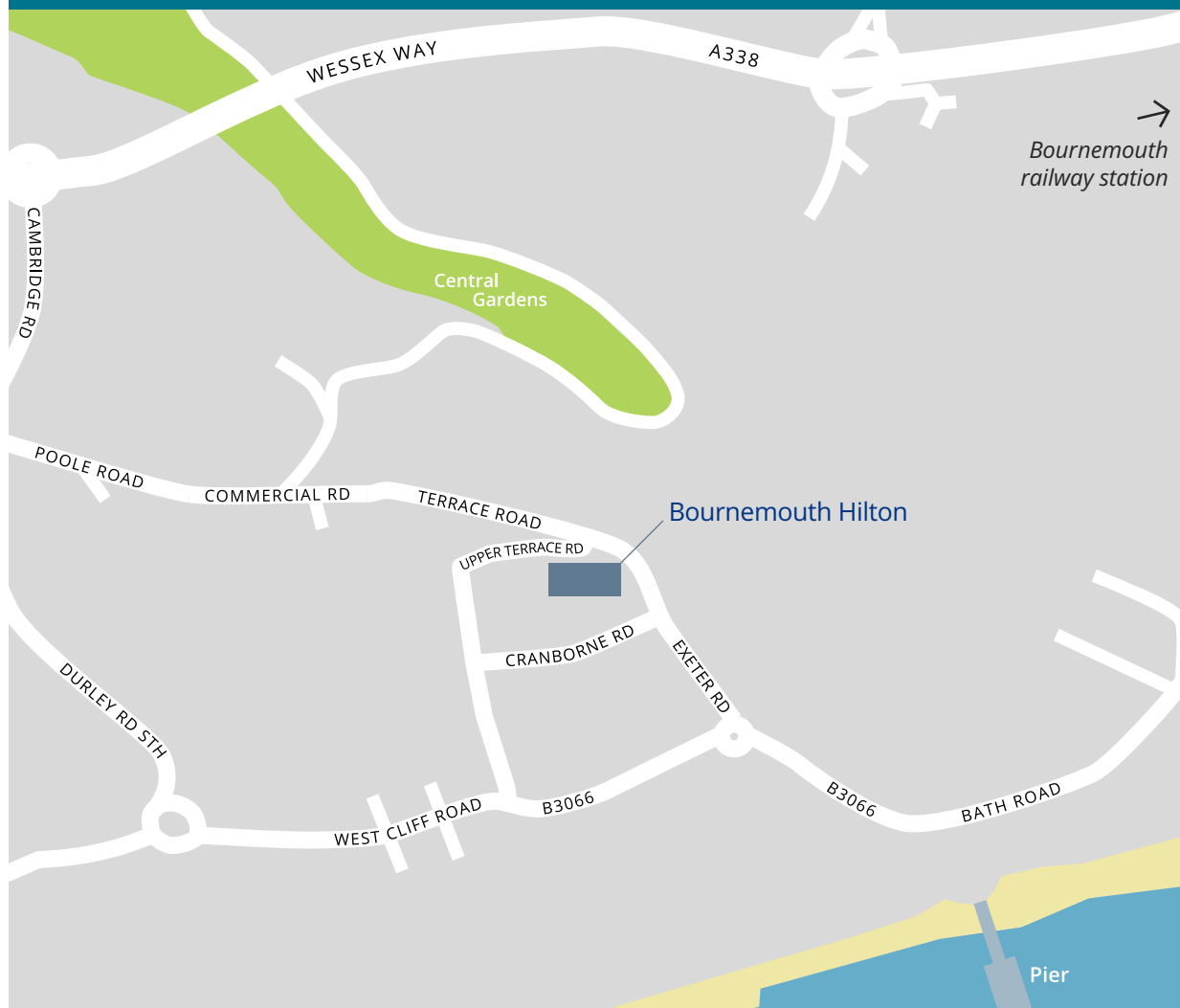

BY ROAD:

On the M27 going southwest, the road merges onto the A31, Ringwood Road. Take the A338 to Bournemouth. Follow the signs to Bournemouth Town Centre West. Go straight over the first roundabout and at the next roundabout, take the first left towards the BIC and Town Centre West. Going up a short incline, at the next roundabout, take the first left on Poole Road - you are about 1/3 mile to the hotel.
